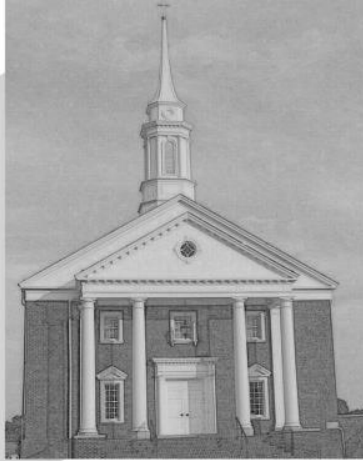

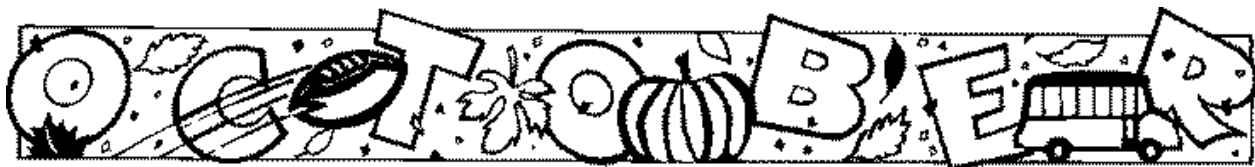
All Saints Sunday will be observed on Sunday, November 5th. Please send the names of anyone who has passed since last November into the office by October 27th.

What about the turkeys?? – To help cover the cost of the turkeys – Giant will be helping us but we need your help also. Donating Giant gift cards will be a true blessing! The cards will be used to pay for the turkeys (which will be sold to us at cost) – **please, only Giant** gift cards as that is where we will be purchasing the turkeys from.
