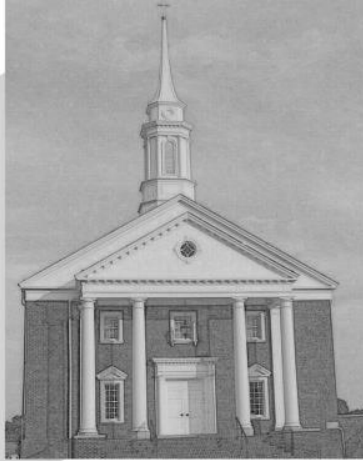

Confirmation

Leader: Brothers and sisters in Christ: Through the Sacrament of Baptism we are invited into Christ’s holy Church. We are incorporated into God’s mighty acts of salvation and given new birth through water and the Spirit. All this is God’s gift, offered to us without price. Through Confirmation and through the reaffirmation of our faith, we renew the covenant declared at our baptism, acknowledge what God is doing for us, and affirm our commitment to Christ’s holy Church. I present these persons for confirmation and to formally join into full membership of this church as adults. Since the earliest times, the vows of Christian baptism have consisted first of the renunciation of all that is evil and then the profession of faith and loyalty to Christ. Candidates for confirmation profess for themselves the solemn vows that were made at their baptism.

Invitation to Church Membership

Leader: On behalf of the whole Church, I ask you: Do you renounce the spiritual forces of wickedness, reject the evil powers of this world, and repent of your sins?

Leader: Do you confess Jesus Christ as your Savior, put your whole trust in his grace, and promise to serve him as your Lord, in union with the Church which Christ has opened to people of all ages, nations, and races?

Confirmands: I do.

To the Congregation:

Leader: Will you nurture these persons in Christ’s Holy Church, that by your teaching and example they may be guided to accept God’s grace for themselves, to profess their faith openly, and to lead a Christian life?

People: We will.

To the Confirmands:

Leader: Will you be faithful to Perry Hall United Methodist Church with your prayers, your presence, your gifts, your service and your proclamation of Jesus Christ as Lord?

Confirmands: I will.

Leader: Now it is our joy to welcome our new brothers and sisters in Christ. Through baptism you were incorporated by the Holy Spirit into God's new creation and made to share in Christ's royal; priesthood. We are all one in Christ Jesus. With joy and thanksgiving we welcome you as members of this family of Christ.
