

**Food Pantry News** - The food pantry continues to serve community members in record numbers. In fact, our appointments are usually completely filled 3 weeks out. In October the pantry served 100 families (over 300 people). This mission cannot exist without the support of the congregation – thank you to all who donate food and your time. Our most needed food items are canned vegetables, canned fruit, rice, peanut butter, jelly, tuna, and cereal. We also need volunteers to work on Saturday mornings or people who are willing to be a substitute. ### **The Food Pantry May Close! Did that get catch your attention?? Read on!**

Many of you are aware then in 2017 we served approximately 3000 people through our food pantry, not only with food but with warm, loving attitudes, and concern for others. In 2018 our numbers most likely will be even higher. We greatly appreciate all the donations that had come in from a variety of sources both within the church and outside the church. This is been a true blessing to others and to our congregation.

However, what many people may not realize is that all of this is done on a volunteer basis, from the person's distributing food, stocking shelves, putting baskets together, mailings and more. We also have a Coordinator who is in charge of seeing that the food bank continues to operate smoothly. We have had several wonderful leaders in recent years who have helped to grow the program into what it is today.

However, we have reached a point where we have a critical need for a coordinator who will oversee the program in 2019. The sad reality is without a coordinator the Food Pantry will have to close.

Please if you would like to see this much-needed service to our community continue we need someone to step forward **NOW**. If not, the Food Pantry will not exist in 2019 and literally thousands of people will not receive the help but they have in past years.

**December 2<sup>nd</sup>** - Biscuit or Corn Bread mix, canned green beans

All food items need to be at church by Sunday, December 9<sup>th</sup>. There will be a grocery cart inside the back door from the parking lot and a container in the narthex for your donations.
