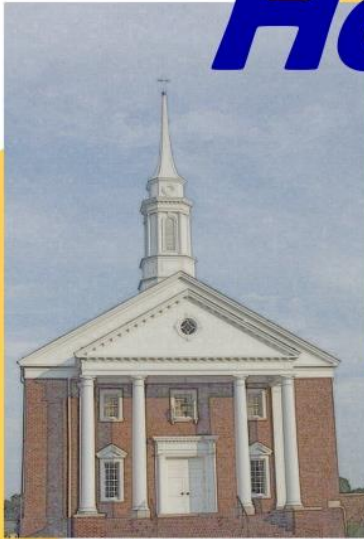

Postal service comes to PHUMC – Why not share your Christmas blessings with your church family by using the PHUMC Post Office? On the second floor, just outside the Sunday School office, you will find boxes with the letters of the alphabet on them. The first thing you do is to put the names of the people on the cards and drop them in the corresponding boxes (by the first letter of the last name). Then check the boxes each week with the first letter of your last name and pick up the cards that have your name on it. The **PHUMC Post Office** is open from **Dec 2nd through Jan. 6th**, after that date, any cards left over will be tossed or recycled. Please make sure you send cards to people through the PHUMC Post Office that actively come to church.
