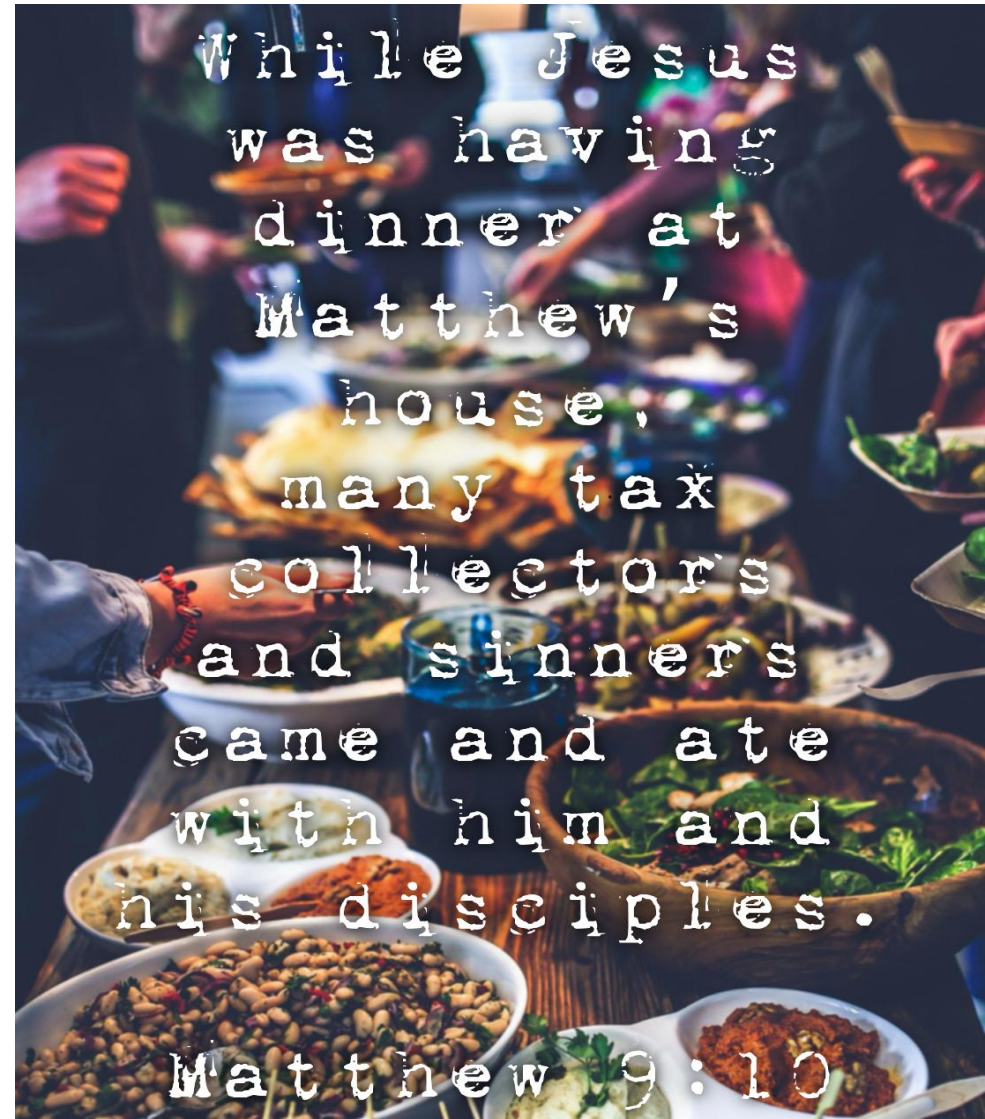

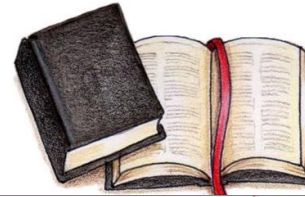

SCRIPTURE READERS NEEDED

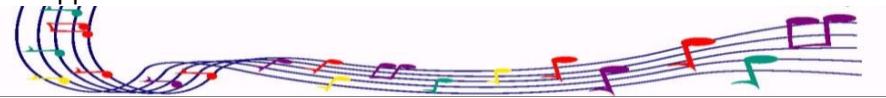
Do you enjoy sharing your love for God with others?
